Company Overview:

Right Way Environmental Contractors, Inc. started operations in 1995 in Barranquitas, Puerto Rico. The company is owned and operated by Teresa Rivera and Pedro Tejada and is classified as a women owned small disadvantaged business.

The company goal is to provide cost efficient and quality services without compromising safety and regulatory compliance. This has been the backbone of our success and remains our guiding principle.

RWEC, Inc. has focused on construction and environmental remediation projects involving active and inactive military bases, under regular federal contracts, BRAC and the “DERP” “FUDS” program. We have performed for the US Army Corps of Engineers the successful closure of over 150 UST with nominal capacities ranging from 500 gallons to 50,000 gallons, with one project alone including 24 each 50 K gallon tanks and 48 each 25 K gallon tanks, the disposal of 1 million gallons of liquid wastes and 10,000 c/y of contaminated soil. The project was completed on a tight schedule of six months. As a USEPA contractor we have performed emergency services on the aftermath of various hurricanes in Vieques, Culebra and St. Thomas, USVI.
