## SBA 8(A) ADVANTAGES

**No \$\$ Ceiling Limit - CFR 124.506(b) / FAR 19.805-1(b)**

Tribal-owned 8(a) companies can be awarded sole-source federal contracts with no competition and no competitive threshold dollar limitation on the contract amount. Limits that apply to other 8(a) companies do not apply to Tribal Owned firms; however, a procurement may not be removed from planned competition to sole source it to an Tribal-owned firm.

**Non-Protestable 13 CFR 124.517(a)**

Contracts awarded directly to an 8(a) through a sole source or competitive 8(a) requirement may not be protested. The ability to fast track an important procurement is a huge benefit.
