**Farrenburg Levee Renovation Phase 1 Culvert Replacement 2016\_2019**

Value: \$ 2,848,671.00

The Job: The Corp of Engineers Memphis District had a requirement for culvert replacements at Culvert # 4 on the New Madrid-Sikeston Ridge Levee with an option in the project to replace culvert # 3 as well. The work would include some clearing and grubbing, placing 6" compacted crushed limestone on the levee crown and completely removing and replacing the existing culverts. C & M Contractors, Inc. installed a cast in place outlet structure with a 72" flared end section and a 72" sluice gate with a gate lift assembly. During the early spring of 2019 there was possible flooding in the area and C & M Contractors, Inc. mobilized employees and equipment within a few hours to build cofferdams and build the levee up an extra two feet in order to protect the area. There is also a requirement for unwatering and dewatering in the areas of the outlet structure. This project is scheduled to be completed in December of 2020, with the ability to work in the non work periods when feasible we anticipate finishing this project early.

**NPS-JNEM North/South Overlook Stairs: 2017\_2018** Value: \$ 4,401,917.50

This project for the National Park Service was a part of the Jefferson National Expansion Memorial in St. Louis, Mo. at the base of the Arch. The stairs that needed repair are located on the east side of the Eleanor K. Sullivan promenade along the Mississippi River. The work consisted of repairing and waterproofing of the overlook platform, overlook stairs, and the top of the river wall. This project had a LEED rating system and was required to be in compliance with the US Green Buildings Council's Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design. Part of this work required C & M Contractors to get a right of way permit from the railroad as there had to be some concrete tuckpointing at the entrance to the train underpass. We also worked very close with the design team for the National Park Service in order to get the required colors and textures of concrete to match the existing construction that was not being disturbed. This project has a requirement to be completed in 300 days and C & M Contractors, Inc. along with our sub contractors on this project finished under the required time and on budget.

**Wappapello Parks & Road Maintenance IDIQ: 2017\_2019** Value: \$ 4,000,000.00

This is an Indefinite Delivery Indefinite Quantity Contract that had the base year and 2 option years. Originally this contract was for a total of \$2,059,000.00 for a three year period. In 2018, there was a modification awarded that increased the amount to \$ 4.0 million total. At the end of 2018, C & M Contractors has been awarded twenty one (21) task orders. In 2017, the total of all task orders met the original contract amount. The variety of task order types has been quite extensive. Task Orders included the following types of work. Spreading sand on beaches, placing rip rap on ditch banks, building a green house, demolition of a gatehouse and installing a new CXT building, laying asphalt and resurfacing existing asphalt parking lots, Striping those lots, installing signs, mowing the roadsides, cleaning ditches, grading roads and more. Some of the Parks needed new bike and walking trails and we were able to build those as well as rebuilding several of the campsites. We were able to make several of the campsites larger and added lamp posts to them. The twenty one task order required extensive coordination and scheduling both internally as well as with the customer.
