Past performance



MSI/TetraTech (Agency: USAID) (2021-2026): As a subcontractor to MSI/TetraTech on the Venezuela Monitoring and Evaluation Project (VMEP) for USAID BHA, i-APS maintains a Venezuela country office and manages all personnel and logistics to conduct up to 100 site visits per year. As of Sept. 2024, i-APS has conducted over 230 site visits, with zero security incidents and data quality at over 99%. i-APS has trained over 30 Venezuelan nationals using its training platform **KAP** course.
